Admission Requirements

Category A

- Bachelor's Degree in Film/Television/Motion Picture Production
- Bachelor's Degree in Mass Communication/Theatre Arts/etc.—with evidence of course work and or final project in film production or film studies; and
- HND in Film/Television/Motion Picture Production plus a PGD in any discipline.
- Holders of any of the qualifications listed in Category A shall be admitted directly to the second semester of the programme.

Category B

- Bachelor's Degree in any discipline [preferably in the humanities and social sciences]
- HND in any discipline.
- Holders of any of the qualifications listed in Category B shall be admitted directly to the first semester of the programme.

ENTRANCE EXAM TYPE

Candidates will be expected to undergo an aptitude test, essay writing and oral assessment (Lagos only).

Candidates with current or recent satisfactory scores in GRE or GMAT will be exempted from the aptitude test but will be assessed via essay writing and an oral interview.

Notwithstanding the duration and the study mode, the admission application package must include the copy of a short film [of between five and 10 minutes-even if shot with a hand phone] made by the candidate.
